PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing will be held by and before the Planning Commission of the City of Troy at City Hall, 500 W. Big Beaver, Troy, Michigan, on Tuesday, February 27, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the agenda will permit, to consider a proposed one-family cluster development currently known as **Whispering Park** in Section 11, at which time the Planning Commission will consider (1) rezoning the northern 200 feet of property from EP Environmental Protection to R-1C One Family Residential, and (2) the Preliminary Site Plan in accordance with Article 10, Section 10.04, of the City of Troy Zoning Ordinance. The applicant has voluntarily placed conditions associated with the proposed rezoning.

The proposed one-family cluster development is located **north of Long Lake, west of John R** (parcels 88-20-11-401-001 and 88-20-11-328-003). The proposed development is for **50 units/lots** on approximately **18 acres** within the R-1C (One Family Residential) and EP (Environmental Protection) zoning district. The Planning Commission is a recommending body for this application. City Council has the approval authority.
